3rd Meeting of China-UK Green Finance Taskforce

November 30 2018, London

The 9th China-UK Economic and Financial Dialogue (EFD) calls for the China-UK Green Finance Taskforce, established by China Green Finance Committee and City of London Green Finance Initiative, to continue to promote public and private collaboration in the green finance area between the two countries. Focus areas for the taskforce include: 1) conduct analysis on measures to promote green asset securitization in China and the UK; 2) discuss and draft a set of voluntary guidelines on greening the Belt and Road investment; 3) conduct analysis to demonstrate a positive correlation between ESG and financial performance and 4) conduct pilot projects on climate risk and environmental information disclosure consistent with the TCFD recommendations by Chinese and UK financial institutions.

In 2018, the Taskforce has been working closely with relevant stakeholders on the four topics and completed their research or studies which are ready for release and feeding into the 10th China-UK EFD. For example, through collaboration with PRI, IFC-supported SBN, ICBC led Belt & Road Bankers Roundtable, Green Belt and Road Investors Alliance, World Economic Forum, and the Paulson Institute, the Taskforce developed the *Green Investment Principles for the Belt and Road* (GIP). Financial institutions from both countries have developed an action plan for environmental information disclosure consistent with TCFD recommendations. In addition, the Taskforce also worked on other topics and will launch their research findings respectively.

This meeting will discuss what has been achieved in these four areas, agree on inputs to the 10th UK-China EFD, and explore topics for the year 2019.
